Rules	Tentative Schedule
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Campers are not allowed to leave the campground without permission.</li> <li>2. Kitchen &amp; staff cabins are off limits to all campers.</li> <li>3. Campers are not allowed to change rooms or visit other rooms.</li> <li>4. Campers should not wear other campers' clothes or accessories. <b>The camp is not responsible for loss of belongings.</b></li> <li>5. All long distance phone calls may be made by using phone cards or by making collect calls. <b>Permission must be granted by Office staff.</b></li> <li>6. Campers must attend all scheduled activities, including devotions, classes, evening services, etc.</li> <li>7. Campers are not permitted to leave the Tabernacle at night, until the official dismissal by the Camp director / supervisor.</li> <li>8. Campers must keep their rooms tidy, as room inspections happen any time. Wet clothes can be washed &amp; dried in the camp dryer.</li> <li>9. All campers must bathe or shower daily.</li> <li>10. Campers must use restroom facilities before church and bedtime.</li> <li>11. No running or loitering in the upstairs dorm or the dining hall.</li> <li>12. Front pews are reserved for the campers.</li> <li>13. Canteen money must be left in the office at registration.</li> <li>14. Put all waste, including candy wrappers, etc. in garbage barrels. Pop cans are refundable at the canteen.</li> <li>15. No camper can go swimming until the scheduled time, and must be accompanied by the pool supervisors and/or the life guard. <b>No mixed bathing.</b> Everyone must be fully covered when going to / from the pool.</li> <li>16. Respect to camp property and to camp staff will be enforced.</li> <li>17. <b>No profane language will be tolerated.</b></li> <li>18. <b>Do not bring: gum, water balloons, radio/tape/mp3 player, I-pods or bad attitudes.</b></li> <li>19. Campers must be picked up 1 hour after scheduled dismissal of each camp.</li> <li>20. No inappropriate affection to be shown! High 5's only.</li> <li>21. Clothing restrictions: NO SHORTS, NO GIRLS wearing SLACKS, NO CUT-OFFS, NO HALTER TOPS, OR TANK TOPS.
