Rules	Tentative Schedule
<p>1. Campers are not allowed to leave the campground without permission.</p> <p>2. Kitchen & staff cabins are off limits to all campers.</p> <p>3. Campers are not allowed to change rooms or visit other rooms.</p> <p>4. Campers should not wear other campers' clothes or accessories. The camp is not responsible for loss of belongings.</p> <p>5. All long distance phone calls may be made by using phone cards or by making collect calls. Permission must be granted by Office staff.</p> <p>6. Campers must attend all scheduled activities, including devotions, classes, evening services, etc.</p> <p>7. Campers are not permitted to leave the Tabernacle at night, until the official dismissal by the Camp director / supervisor.</p> <p>8. Campers must keep their rooms tidy, as room inspections happen at random times. Wet clothes can be washed & dried in the camp dryer.</p> <p>9. All campers must shower daily.</p> <p>10. Campers must use restroom facilities before church and at bedtime.</p> <p>11. No running or loitering in the upstairs dorm or the dining hall.</p> <p>12. Sit in designated pews, reserved for the campers.</p> <p>13. Canteen money must be left in the office at registration.</p> <p>14. Put all waste, including candy wrappers, etc. in garbage barrels. Pop cans are refundable at the canteen.</p> <p>15. No camper can go swimming until the scheduled time, and must be accompanied by the pool supervisors and/or the life guard. No mixed bathing. Everyone must be fully covered when going to / from the pool.</p> <p>16. Respect to camp property and to camp staff will be enforced.</p> <p>17. No profane language will be tolerated.</p> <p>18. Do not bring: gum, water balloons, or bad attitudes.</p> <p>19. Campers must be picked up 1 hour after scheduled dismissal of each camp.</p> <p>20. No inappropriate affection to be shown! High 5's only.</p> <p>21. Clothing restrictions: NO SHORTS, NO CUT-OFFS, NO HALTER TOPS, OR TANK TOPS. NO GIRLS wearing SLACKS,. It is not recommended for campers to bring valuables or excessive jewelry.</p> <p>22. All Youth camp attendees must go to the dining room after evening canteen!!!</p> <p>23.
